II 次の英文を読み、あとの設問に答えなさい。

For many of us, Christmas \*has turned into an exercise in \*frenzied shopping, generating more stress than the workplace. Maybe it's a good time to \*reflect on how blessed we are to be celebrating Christmas at all, and the story of a Christmas (a)miracle that happened over ( A ) ago.

On Christmas Eve 1914, with World War I only five months old, German, French and British soldiers cautiously laid down their rifles, approached the \*barbed wire separating the two sides, and began to \*fraternize in the true Christmas spirit. Widely known as the Christmas \*truce, the incident \*has spawned movies, writings and (b)legends for an entire century.

Nothing so \*wondrous or hopeful has happened in a war since, and the Christmas truce remains shining \*testimonial to what happens when men \*halt violence in the name of Christmas and the human (c)spirit.

The truce began when British soldiers on the Western Front that ran through France and Belgium heard Christmas carols coming from the muddy \*trenches of their German enemies.

Both sides had been fighting since the summer and despite rumors that war would be over by December, there they all were, facing each other in the cold and mud. But the singing set off more singing, this time on the British side. Some of the men called out to each other, ( B ) got up and walked very carefully toward the barbed wire. Though many still held their rifles, no one was firing and there are tales of an \*impromptu soccer game between Germany and England ( won 3-2 by the Germans ), the exchange of (d)cigars and whiskey, and \*makeshift trees on the trench tops.

It all ended a few hours later. The commanders on both sides \*took steps to ensure such a thing would not happen again. For a few glorious hours, the men \*reveled in the joy of peace but the war went ( C ) for another four years.

Japan is a country far to the east in Asia. Since the sun rises in the east, Japan has long been called "the land of the rising sun." A rising sun is pictured on the flag of Japan, which has a ( A ) circle on a ( B ) background.

Compared to China, Japan is a very small country. [あ] The four main islands are really the tops of a great \*mountain range. There are many volcanoes in Japan, and there are many earthquakes.

In Japan you'll find one of the largest cities in the world, called Tokyo. [い] Tokyo is a busy, crowded, modern city, with many banks, stores, restaurants, museums, colleges, and apartment buildings.

If you were to visit a Japanese family living in an apartment in Tokyo, the first thing you would do when you entered their home would be to ( C ) your shoes. You would wear socks or special slippers, but you would never wear your outside shoes indoors!

If your Japanese friends invited you to stay for dinner, you might not sit in a chair but instead \*kneel on a cushion around a low table. To pick up your food, you would not use a fork—and no, you wouldn't use your fingers, but (3)two slender pieces of wood about the size of pencils, called chopsticks.

In many ways, Japan is very modern country. [う] It has busy factories that make cars, televisions, radios, cameras, and other products that are bought by people around the world.

( D ) there is more to Japan than a lot of modern business and industry. In Japan the people also care about their old ways and customs. For example, children in Japan learn a very old art form called *origami*. To do *origami*, you fold paper in special ways, without cutting or pasting it, to make lovely figures such as a frog or a \*crane. [え]
