Documents recently published by Britain's Parliament show that the spire on the 96-meter-high tower is nearly half a meter out of line.

However, experts said it would take thousands of years before the tilt matches that of Italy's Leaning Tower of Pisa.

“We’re talking about unbelievably small (11),” said John Burland, an engineering professor at Imperial College London (12) has been involved in the study of the tower.

Big Ben has moved (13) than 1 mm a year since experts began measuring it in the 1970s, Burland said.

Mike McCann, who is charged with looking (14) the tower’s clockwork, said such imperfections are a fact of life for older buildings.

“The Victorians didn’t have lasers or modern surveying equipment,” he said. “It was never going to be straight to start (15).
