Ryzhik, a scruffy red tabby cat, was found two years ago on the cold streets of the Siberian city of Tomsk, his four ( 11 ) completely ( 12 ). Had it not been ( 13 ) Russian veterinarian Sergei Gorshkov, he might be dead today.

Now, Ryzhik hobbles around on four \*prosthetic limbs at Gorshkov's clinic in Novosibirsk, about 200 kilometers away from Tomsk. The vet implanted the four titanium limbs into Ryzhik's bones. Dentists use a (14) technique to implant false teeth into their patients' mouths.

Ryzhik is one of the first cats in the world to have four titanium ( 11 ) implanted into their bones using the technique, said Gorshkov.

The other cat, Dymka, now leads a typical life of a house cat with her owner.

"She runs, jumps and plays. Her owner sends videos of how she moves," Gorshkov said. "It's a great result. We are very ( 15 ). We did not expect this."

By blood she was Albanian. By citizenship she was Indian. To most, she was known as Mother Teresa, a little nun in a white and blue sari who dedicated her life to caring for the poorest in Kolkata. There, in the slums, she opened a hospice for the penniless, a home for \*leprosy sufferers and an \*orphanage for abandoned children. She taught them to bathe, to pray and to read and write ----scrawling letters in the dirt with sticks. In 2016, the Roman Catholic Church canonized her as Saint Teresa.

Despite her hallowed image, some have questioned how saintly she really was. The main complaint is that instead ( 18 ) trying to cure the people she rescued, Mother Teresa glorified their suffering.

A report by a team of Canadian researchers suggested that although her mission received hundreds of thousands of dollars in donations, her homes lacked drugs, painkillers and other basic equipment. As a result, many inmates suffering ( 19 ) treatable conditions died. It is also unclear where the millions of dollars she received have gone.

In his book, *The Missionary Position*, journalist Christopher Hitchens claimed that Mother Teresa saw the suffering of the poor not as an opportunity to help them, ( 20 ) as a way to show her devotion to God. "I think it is very beautiful for the poor to accept their lot, to share it with the passion of Christ," he quotes her as saying.

When we read that Mother Teresa refused the banquet for her Nobel Peace Prize in 1979, requesting that the budget be donated to the poor, it seems natural to think of her as a humanitarian. But there are good reasons to think the truth about her life was much more complicated.
